Reverse Logistics and Packaging Recyclability

Dear Customers and Partners,

At PolySell, we remain steadfast in our commitment to sustainability. As part of this commitment, we implement reverse logistics for our packaging through the offsetting of environmental credits. This initiative ensures the proper disposal of waste and contributes the preservation of the environment.

Furthermore, our packaging is **100% recyclable** when subjected to a proper **triple-rinse** process. This step is essential to removing any remaining residue and allow the material to be reintegrated into the production cycle.

Packaging Rinse Instructions

- 1. Completely empty the packaging;
- 2. Add clean water until it reaches one-quarter of its volume;
- 3. Close the container tightly and shake vigorously for 30 seconds;
- 4. Discard the rinse water;
- 5. Repeat this process two more times (three rinses in total);
- 6. Render the plastic packaging unusable by puncturing the bottom;
- 7. Deliver the packaging to an authorized recycling facility in your region.

Please note: Packaging that cannot be rinsed — such as plastic bags, metallized bags, or mixed-material paper bags — should be disposed of as regular waste.
